Eight years ago, Providence (PVD) Promise set out to build early, college-going mindsets for Providence students. Since 2017, nearly 1,300 students have saved \$2.35 Million in 529 College Savings Accounts (CSAs) and participated in hundreds of programs, among other tremendous outcomes.

PVD Promise is coming to the end of a threeyear strategic plan. ## **Youth Engagement**

The Youth Engagement Program provides targeted college and career readiness support to enrolled middle and high school students. This includes resume and cover letter writing workshops, FAFSA and college application support, a "Hacking the Campus Code" series, and individual advising sessions to help students understand their financial packages, plan for their future, and more.

As with the Family Engagement program, PVD Promise collaborates with several community partner organizations and financial institutions to make its youth services accessible to students.

#### Workshops and Events

In 2024, the Youth Engagement Program hosted 35 total workshops and events.

The new Alumni Program provides PVD Promise graduates in post-secondary programs with Early Scholarship opportunities, advising, and a supportive community.

## **Mentorship Program**

The Mentorship Program pairs college students with enrolled middle and high school students, offering critical, individualized college and career support, such as bi-weekly one-on-ones, mentorship events, one on-site college visit, guiding program curriculum, program incentives, and more. Piloted in 2021, the number of mentor-mentee pairs increased from 36 during the 2023-2024 program year to 40 pairs in 2024-2025 (data below is for the midpoint of the 2024-2025 season, **only**).

# **Early Scholarships**

The Early Scholarship Program offers hundreds of opportunities for students and their parents/guardians to earn money for higher education when they participate in certain activities, such as writing a book report, completing the FAFSA, attending a parent-teacher conference, being involved in PVD Promise programming, and much more.

#### Incentive Awards



## Finance

#### A snapshot of revenue & expenses

Given the continued, significant demand for our services, PVD Promise's general operating budget during FYE 25 (July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025) was \$885,000. In 2024, PVD Promise incurred \$931,675 in expenses, with the largest expenses being for the provision of program services and Early Scholarship incentive awards.





Thanks to our network of generous supporters, PVD Promise raised \$847,603 to support this growth in 2024.

When it comes to fundraising, PVD Promise continues to outperform the previous years' results. In 2024, PVD Promise received 721 contributions from 524 individual, corporate, foundation, and other donors.

In 2024, PVD Promise had the most successful 529 Day Campaign yet, raising more than \$165,000 from 70 corporate, foundation and individual sponsors. Similarly, Giving Tuesday 2024 was the biggest individual donor campaign to date, raising \$135,000 from individual donors for the Early Scholarship Program.
