Comments from the Executive Director

Dear Supporters,

Just like that, we've entered the last quarter of our fiscal year (7/1/23 - 6/30/24)!

Providence (PVD) Promise continues to experience historic growth. Demand for our services remains high and we've enrolled 228 students since July of 2023. Currently, our total enrollment is over 1,280 students from more than 680 families. Participation in the Family Engagement, Youth Engagement and Early Scholarships Programs has increased, as more than 2,000 students and parents/guardians attended 88 unique programs since July 2023. Meanwhile, families have earned \$240,000 in Early Scholarship incentives. As a result of Early Scholarship incentives, family contributions and market return, families have saved nearly \$2,000,000 in 529 College Savings Accounts (CSAs) since 2017.

While we anticipated an increase in program participation concurrent with new student enrollments, the uptake of our programming has been even more significant than expected. In fact, the cost per student to enroll and participate in our programming has nearly doubled since 2022, due in large part to the interest in our Early Scholarship Program. We are thrilled with the increased uptake of PVD Promise programming and are working fastidiously to meet fundraising goals.

We are so grateful for your continued interest in and advocacy of our work. With a few months left in our fiscal year, we hope you enjoy these highlights and check out how you, as champions of our work, can help carry us across the finish line in June.


